Here are a few random videos about **WikiTree**:

For beginners, I suggest following the steps at signup to enter yourself and back a few generations, with simple “sources” such as ‘Family records on file’. You can then look at Mindy Silva’s video on the ‘Sourcer Extension’. You can change or fix anything as you learn, over time. Focus on a few families that you have good sources for, add them to (or verify quality of) their FamilySearch profile, then explore using the Sourcer Extension – starting by attaching a few sources, one at a time, then move up.

Begin with solid basics and learn deliberately over time. Nurture the Tree that gave you life.
